PROCEDURES FOR YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

- 1. All applications must be submitted on forms obtained from the ARBA office, District Director, ARBA website or Scholarship committee member. Computer forms will not be accepted unless in original format. *Use the spaces provided only*.
- 2. All applicants must have held continuous ARBA membership for at least three (3) years preceding application for scholarship.
- 3. Applicants must be a graduating senior to be eligible for consideration.
- 4. Applicants must have completed high school with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 (un-weighted) on a grade scale of 4.00, and be in the tip 50% of graduating class.
- 5. Applicants may be currently enrolled in their first year of advanced education.
- 6. Home schooled applicants are eligible, but must submit SAT or ACT scores, and a letter of recommendation from a person outside of the immediate family.
- 7. All applications must include a complete High School transcript, plus a transcript of any advanced education.
- 8. Scholarship proceeds may be used to further education at any accredited four (4) year college, two (2) year college, vocational, or technical school.
- 9. Per Article III (I) in the By-laws of the ARBA Constitution: "Scholarships will be paid to the member upon receipt of confirmation of college enrollment."
- 10. A member of the immediate family of any ARBA Youth Scholarship Committee member will be eligible to apply, but the committee member will not be able to submit scoring information for that year.
- 11. APPLICATIONS must not exceed the space provided with a maximum of 15 pages.
- 12. All applications must be sent to the ARBA office by $July 31^{st}$ of application year.

NOTE: The ARBA Youth Scholarship Committee applications are only accepted for scoring at the completion of your Senior Year of High School. For example, if you are graduating in 2016, then this is the year you need to apply. If you don't graduate until 2017, or graduated in a previous year, your application will not be considered.
